A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF \$203,143 IN GRANT FUNDING FROM THE CALIFORNIA GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES' LAW ENFORCEMENT SPECIALIZED UNIT PROGRAM FOR THE FRESNO POLICE DEPARTMENT'S DOMESTIC VIOLENCE UNIT 2024 LAW ENFORCEMENT SPECIALIZED UNIT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Fresno Police Department (grant applicant) desires to undertake a project to work in partnership with Marjaree Mason Center (MMC) for the purpose of providing maximum available assistance for victims of domestic violence and their children within the City of Fresno to be funded in part from state grant funds made available through the 2024 Law Enforcement Specialized Unit Program from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services' Law Enforcement Specialized Unit Program; and

WHEREAS, the governing body approves the receiving of grant funding from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services' Law Enforcement Specialized Unit Program for the Fresno Police Department's Domestic Violence Unit 2024 Law Enforcement Specialized Unit Program.

- 1. The Council authorizes the acceptance of grant funding from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services' Law Enforcement Specialized Unit Program for the Fresno Police Department's Domestic Violence Unit 2024 Law Enforcement Specialized Unit Program in the amount of two hundred three thousand, one hundred forty-three dollars (\$203,143).
- 2. The Chief of Police for the City of Fresno is authorized and directed to sign on its behalf to accept the funding and execute the Grant Agreement, including any extensions or amendments thereof, subject to prior approval as to form by the City Attorney's Office.
- 3. The City of Fresno agrees to abide by the statutes and regulations governing the Law Enforcement Specialized Unit Program, as well as, the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement, including any liability arising from civil court actions for damages..
- 4. The grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this governing body.
