WHEREAS, the CITY has in its employ Fire department response personnel including: Fire Deputy Chief, Fire Battalion Chief, Fire Captain, Firefighter Specialist/Engineer, Firefighter, Fire Equipment Mechanic I, Fire Equipment Mechanic II, Fire Equipment Mechanic Lead Worker, Equipment Service Worker I, and Equipment Mechanic Service Worker II; and

WHEREAS, the CITY will compensate its employees portal to portal while in the course of their employment and away from their official duty station and assigned to an emergency incident, in support of an emergency incident, or pre-positioned for emergency response; and

WHEREAS, the CITY will compensate its employees' overtime, with the exception of the Fire Deputy Chief, in accordance with their current Memorandum of Understanding while in the course of their employment and away from their official duty station and assigned to an emergency incident, in support of an emergency incident, or pre-positioned for emergency response; and

WHEREAS, the CITY will compensate the Fire Deputy Chief, when assigned, portal to portal at the straight-time hourly rate for hours worked in excess of their regularly assigned shift, and derived from their base salary as defined in their current Memorandum of Understanding, while in the course of their employment away from their official duties and assigned to an emergency incident, in support of an emergency incident, or pre-positioned for emergency response; and

WHEREAS, the CITY will submit an invoice, per the California Fire Assistance Agreement, to the proper agency for reimbursement of employee costs related to the response to an emergency incident, in support of an emergency incident, or prepositioned for emergency response.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno, that the conditions set forth in this resolution, as sated above, take effect upon adoption by the Fresno City Council.
