- 1. The Agreement is hereby extended by one (1) additional year and the expiration date shall be June 30, 2017.
- 2. CONSULTANT'S sole compensation for satisfactory performance of all services required or rendered pursuant to this Second Amendment, shall not exceed \$42,000.00 for the period July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2017.
- 3. Except as otherwise provided herein, the Agreement entered into by CITY and CONSULTANT, effective July 1, 2014, remains in full force and effect.
