## Federal Inspection Station (FIS) User Fee per Deplaning International Passenger

The purpose of this fee is to recover staffing and other costs required to operate the FIS facility. The FIS fee was reduced from \$15.00 to \$14.00 in FY 2011, and has remained constant over the last five years.

Customs and Border Patrol (CBP) has repeatedly postponed the assignment of Port of Entry (POE) status to Fresno Yosemite International (FAT) – Airports meets all the requirements. The POE designation would transfer staffing costs to CBP and likely result in a reduced FIS User Fee. CBP's posture forces Airports to charge an FIS User Fee that is among the highest in the country.

FY 2016 international deplaning passengers are estimated to be eighteen (18) percent higher than FY 2015 passengers. Higher international passengers allow Airports to reduce the FIS User Fee from \$14.00 to \$12.00, and still recover sufficient operating and capital costs consistent with the Federal Aviation Administration rate-setting guidance.
