NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

- 1. The Council, on its own motion, submits to the electors of the City of Fresno at its general municipal election to be consolidated with the statewide general election to be held on November 8, 2016, a ballot measure proposing to amend the Charter of the City of Fresno as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto, and incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. The question to be submitted to the electors with respect to the proposed Charter amendments as set forth in Exhibit A shall be printed on the election ballot with the title and in the form hereinafter set forth:

Sec. 1208 (a) (2) —Procurement and Competitive Bidding requires bids to be submitted as follows: "All bids hereunder shall be submitted in <u>a sealed envelope</u> and shall be filed with the officer in charge of the purchasing function prior to the opening time specified in the notice inviting bids. Such officer shall receive and be custodian of such bids and keep the same confidential until they are opened and declared."

- 4. The Fresno City Clerk shall file a certified copy of this resolution with the Fresno County Elections Office on or before July 29, 2016.
- 5. The Fresno City Clerk shall give the appropriate notices for the election and the Fresno County Clerk shall conduct the election pursuant to appropriate provisions of state law.
- 6. The City shall reimburse the County of Fresno for the above mentioned services performed by The Fresno County Clerk/Registrar of Voters, upon presentation of the bill to the City.
- 7. The City Attorney shall prepare an impartial analysis of the measure in accordance with Elections Code Section 9280.

EXHIBIT "A" TO RESOLUTION

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO CHARTER OF CITY OF FRESNO TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE CITY ELECTORS AS A BALLOT MEASURE AT THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVMBER 8, 2016

Sec. 1208 Procurement and Competitive Bidding shall be amended to read:

Every contract involving an expenditure of city moneys of more than one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000), adjusted annually on the first of July to the nearest one thousand dollars (\$1,000) in response to changes in the National Consumer Price Index (United States City Average For All Products), for materials, supplies, equipment or for any public work of improvement, shall be let to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder <u>after notice by publication in a newspaper of general circulation within the city or on the internet</u>, which shall be at least seven days before time for opening bids. For purposes of this subsection, Council shall by ordinance define "public work of improvement".

Sec. 1208 (a) (2)

All bids hereunder shall be submitted in <u>a sealed envelope or electronically</u> shall be filed with the officer in charge of the purchasing function prior to the opening time specified in the notice inviting bids. Such officer shall receive and be custodian of such bids and keep the same confidential until they are opened and declared. The City reserves the right to specify that bids be filed only in a sealed envelope or only electronically on any procurement.
