SECTION 1.

Exhibit 1, Unit 1, Non-Supervisory Blue Collar (Local 39), is hereby amended to modify various classification titles and to provide new salary ranges for certain classes in said Exhibit 1, pursuant to the results of the classification and compensation study required by the Memorandum of Understanding and Side Letter of Agreement between the City and International Union of Operating Engineers, Stationary Engineers, Local 39, effective September 5, 2016.

SECTION 2.

Upon final legislative approval, this Resolution shall become effective September 5, 2016.
