Able Advocates filed Articles of Incorporation on Friday, February 8, 2013 and is approximately three years old, according to public records filed with California Secretary of State. Able Advocates grew out of the shared experiences of a group of young mothers who gathered for lunch, mutual acceptance and support as they faced the challenge of mothering children with special needs. Each parent had a different situation with their child and whereas their situations were diverse, from the onset they held in common the necessity to find programs, services and the support to pursue positive outcomes for their children. Their strength grew from their shared desire for everyone's child to succeed and receive a shot at all opportunities possible, to excel.

Able Advocates had its genesis in the desire for these families to assist others who were facing the same petitions for help, support and a shoulder to cry on. This organization grew to help folks throughout the Central Valley. The motivation to have their children excel encouraged them to find the answers and grow an organization to support other families and decrease the stress as they assume their journey in caring for their children.
