The Engineer's Estimate for this expenditure is \$382,000. The contract price is 24.3% above the Engineer's Estimate. If the overage is greater than 10% or only one bid was received, give explanation:

The apparent low bidder, Valley Construction Engineers, has been determined to be non-responsible as defined by Public Contract Code Section 1103. Granite Construction Company therefore becomes the next lowest responsive, responsible bidder. Their bid is higher than the Engineer's Estimate due to the cost of materials being higher than expected and the traffic control required for the project being more involved than originally planned.
