AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO AGREEMENT TO ESTABLISH PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY AND FUNDING REQUIREMENTS

Environmental Enhancement Program
Transit Oriented Development (TOD) Subprogram
(Construction Phase – Met Block Project)

This Amendment No. 2 to "Agreement to Establish Program Eligibility and Funding	Requirements"
("Amendment No. 2") for the Met Block Project is made and entered into the	day of
, 2016 by and between the Fresno County Transportation Authority ("A	Authority") and
the City of Fresno ("Responsible Agency").	

1. PARTIES. The Authority and the City of Fresno are collectively referred to herein as "the Parties".

2. RECITALS.

2.1 WHEREAS, the Parties previously entered into an "Agreement To Establish Program Eligibility and Funding Requirements," dated September 10, 2014 (Agreement No. 05-52-03-105-R-3B, hereinafter referenced as the "Agreement"), for funding of the Construction Phase of the Met Block Project ("Project") in Fresno County; and

WHEREAS, funding for the Agreement was provided as part of the third round of funding for the Environmental Enhancement Program / Transit Oriented Development (TOD) Subprogram, pursuant to the Measure "C" Strategic Implementation Plan ("SIP"); the Fresno County Measure "C" Extension Expenditure Plan ("Expenditure Plan") and most particularly Appendix F thereto; and the "Fresno County Measure C Transit Oriented Development Program Policies and Guidelines," Appendix I to the SIP and attached as Appendix 1 to the original Agreement; and,

WHEREAS, the Agreement provided for an allocation of Measure "C" Extension funding in the amount of \$121,342, solely for the Construction Phase of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Parties subsequently entered into another agreement, dated October 28, 2015 (Agreement No. 05-52-03-105-R-4B, hereinafter referenced alternatively as "the 2015 Agreement" or "Amendment No. 1"), providing an additional allocation of Measure "C" Extension funding, provided as part of the fourth round of funding for the TOD Subprogram, which also was allocated to the Construction Phase of the Project, in the additional amount of \$108,457, bringing the cumulative total allocation for the Project following approval in 2015 of said Amendment No. 1 to \$229,799; and

WHEREAS, Authority is authorized to approve and revise Project funding for payment to Responsible Agency in accordance with the Agreement, the SIP and the Expenditure Plan regarding the Met Block Project; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Parties, by means of this Amendment No. 2, to provide as part of the fifth round of funding for the TOD Subprogram, an additional allocation of Measure "C" Extension funding, in the maximum (not to exceed)

- amount of \$225,527 for the Construction Phase of the Project, which upon approval of this Amendment No. 2 shall increase the total maximum (not to exceed) amount allocated to the Project to the cumulative sum of \$455,326.
- 2.2 The Parties now desire to amend the statements defining and delineating the Project Scope, Project Schedule and Project Funding Program, as set forth in the original Agreement and effectively modified by the prior approval in 2015 of Amendment No. 1, based on the following:
 - Responsible Agency desires an additional increase in the total allocation of funding through the TOD Subprogram for the Met Block Project. Approval of the additional Measure "C" Extension funding will allow for continued construction of the subject transportation improvement project, the Met Block Project, per the revised Exhibits as more thoroughly described in Section 3.1 of this Amendment No. 2.

3. TERMS.

- 3.1 Exhibit "A" (Project Scope), Exhibit "B" (Project Schedule) and Exhibit "C" (Project Funding Program), which hereinafter shall be referenced collectively the "Original Exhibits" as set forth in Section 1.1 of the original Agreement, which were fully incorporated therein by the provisions of Section 3.23 thereof, and which previously were effectively supplemented by Amendment No. 1, shall be and are hereby replaced by: Exhibit "A2" (Project Scope), Exhibit "B2" (Project Schedule) and Exhibit "C2" (Project Funding Program), which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, commencing upon the Effective Date of this Amendment No. 2 to the Agreement.
- 3.2 All work performed by the Responsible Agency under the Agreement prior to the Effective Date of this Amendment No. 2 shall be governed by and compensated pursuant to the applicable Exhibits and the terms of the original Agreement as previously modified or supplemented by Amendment No. 1. All work performed commencing on or after the Effective Date of this Amendment No. 2 shall be governed by and compensated pursuant to the attached Exhibits A2, B2 and C2 and the terms of the Agreement as modified by this Amendment No. 2.
- 3.3 <u>Effective Date</u>. The Effective Date of this Amendment No. 2 to the Agreement shall be 12:01 a.m. of the day following the date upon which it is signed by the Parties. In the event this Amendment No. 2 to the Agreement is signed by the Parties on different dates, the Effective Date shall be 12:01 a.m. of the day following that date upon which it is signed by the second of the Parties.
- 3.4 All other terms and conditions contained in the Agreement are unaffected by this Amendment No. 2 and shall remain in full force and effect.

Project Phase(s) Scope

The project consists of Construction of off-site improvements along the abutting frontages of the project site consisting of curbs and gutters, sidewalks and paving on Stanislaus Street, Fulton, and Calaveras.

Complete Project Scope

Phase 1 consists of preparation of PS&E and was privately funded. All work is within the existing right-of-way. Phase 3 consists of advertising the project for construction bids, construction of off-site improvements, inspection and construction engineering.

Project Purpose

The purpose of this project is to provide off-site improvements to accommodate higher-density, infill development in the project vicinity.

Transportation Benefit

The project is expected to improve air quality, reduce traffic congestion, and improve circulation and aesthetics in the project vicinity.

Implications of Not Doing the Project

Existing conditions would remain in place including poor driving surface, poor circulation and poor aesthesis hindering adjacent infill site development.

Community Engagement

The project limits are within a moderately populated residential area. Residents and property owners will be kept informed of the Project's status and schedule through the City's Public Works Department and local media.

Construction Staging

The project construction is straightforward in nature and will be constructed in a single phase. Open trenches will be backfilled or plated at the end of daily construction operations. Construction phasing may be implemented due to the potential impacts on adjacent residences, businesses, schools, which use this street to access their property.

Detours

Detours will be provided to ensure access to surrounding property owners.

Current Status

Phase 1 is complete. Phase 2 is not applicable to this project. Phase 3 is currently in progress.
