Existing Conditions

→ Five Parking Structures

- \$3.00 First Hour
- \$1.00 Each Additional Hour
- \$9.00 Max
- Seven Off-Street Surface Lots
 - Off-street lots have a combination of meters and cashiers / Same rates as garages
- Approximately 2,000 On-Street Meters
 - \$0.75 per hour

Study Conclusions

- → Garage occupancy is low
- On-street meters experience high occupancy demand in Government areas
- On-Street Meter short-term parking is priced lower than garages
- Generally parking rates charged for off-street parking monthly contracts are in line with comparable cities, however, many contracts are deeply discounted
- → Meters accept coins only are not dynamic and do not offer mobile apps
- Meters on the peripheral areas of downtown have low or zero occupancy
- → A 33% increase in meter rates will produce approximately \$316,190 additional profit over the 2016 profit reported
- The increased meter revenue can be used to off-set the cost of the deferred maintenance plan proposed by Walter P Moore

Recommendations

- → Increase on-street meter rates to \$1.00 per hour
 - Install "smart" multi-space meters where possible
 - Consider tier/demand pricing that will raise meter rates to \$1.50 per hour for peak demand periods and events
- Raise the meter occupancy permit to \$150.00
- Provide a mobile payment application for on-street meter payments
- Eliminate or move meters with zero occupancy
 - Monitor with periodic occupancy surveys
- → Increase Monthly Contract rates (where possible) to \$60.00 minimum.
