NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Fresno City Planning Commission and City Council, in accordance with the procedures of Chapter 15, Sections 5007 and 5801-5812 of the Fresno Municipal Code (FMC), will conduct public hearings to consider the draft Active Transportation Plan and related Plan Amendment and Environmental Assessment. These applications have been filed by the City of Fresno Development and Resource Management Department Director.

Project Description. The project is the adoption of the Fresno Active Transportation Plan. Adoption of this document would require amendments to the City of Fresno General Plan Paths and Trails Map (Figure MT-2) and amendments to the text of the General Plan. The intent of the Active Transportation Plan is to act as a guidance document for active transportation in the City of Fresno, with the goals of equitably improving the safety and perceived safety of walking and bicycling in Fresno, increasing walking and bicycling trips in Fresno by creating user-friendly facilities, improving the geographic equity of access of walking and bicycling facilities in Fresno, and to fill key gaps in Fresno's walking and bicycling networks.

Project Location. The Active Transportation Plan applies to all land within the City of Fresno Sphere of Influence, as depicted in the map, below.

The specific applications filed for the Project are described as follows:

- 1. Environmental Assessment No. A-16-015 recommends that a Mitigated Negative Declaration be adopted for the proposed Active Transportation Plan and related plan amendment.
- 2. PLAN AMENDMENT NO A-16-015 proposes the amendment of the Paths and Trails Map (Figure MT-2) and related text of the Fresno General Plan to incorporate Active Transportation Plan recommendations.

Public hearings on these items are scheduled with the Fresno Planning Commission and City Council as noted below. The Planning Commission's recommendation is advisory to the City Council. The City Council's action is final.

The recommendations of the Planning Commission for the Environmental Assessment and Plan Amendment will be considered by the City Council.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The project is the adoption of the Fresno Active Transportation Plan. The intent of the Active Transportation Plan is to act as a guidance document for active transportation in the City of Fresno, with the goals of equitably improving the safety and perceived safety of walking and bicycling in Fresno, increasing walking and bicycling trips in Fresno by creating user-friendly facilities, improving the geographic equity of access of walking and bicycling facilities in Fresno, and to fill key gaps in Fresno's walking and bicycling networks. Adoption of Active Transportation Plan would require amendments to the City of Fresno General Plan.

Plan Amendment No. A-16-015 proposes the amendment of the Paths and Trails Map (Figure MT-2) and amendments to the text of the General Plan to incorporate Active Transportation Plan recommendations.

The City of Fresno has conducted an initial study of the above-described project and it has been determined to be a subsequent project that is not fully within the scope of the Master Environmental Impact Report (MEIR) prepared for the Fresno General Plan (SCH # 2012111015). Therefore, the Development and Resource Management Department proposes to adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration for this project.

With the project specific mitigation imposed, there is no substantial evidence in the record that this project may have additional significant, direct, indirect or cumulative effects on the environment that are significant and that were not identified and analyzed in the MEIR. After conducting a review of the

adequacy of the MEIR pursuant to Public Resources Code, Section 21157.6(b)(1), the Development and Resource Management Department, as lead agency, finds that no substantial changes have occurred with respect to the circumstances under which the MEIR was certified and that no new information, which was not known and could not have been known at the time that the MEIR was certified as complete, has become available. The project is not located on a site which is included on any of the lists enumerated under Section 65962.5 of the Government Code including, but not limited to, lists of hazardous waste facilities, land designated as hazardous waste property, hazardous waste disposal sites and others, and the information in the Hazardous Waste and Substances Statement required under subdivision (f) of that Section.

Plan Amendment A-16-015 and the proposed environmental finding have been scheduled to be heard by the Planning Commission on **December 7, 2016** and by the City Council on **December 15, 2016**. The hearing will be held in the Fresno City Council Chambers located at Fresno City Hall, 2nd Floor, 2600 Fresno Street, Fresno, California, 93721. Your written and oral comments are welcomed at the hearing and will be considered in the final decision.


