Furthermore, any terms or conditions contained within any Exhibit or Attachment hereto which purport to modify the allocation of risk between the Parties, provided for within the body of this Amendment, shall be null and void.
- 5. Except as otherwise provided herein, the Agreement entered into by CITY and CONSULTANT, dated June 2, 2015, remains in full force and effect.
