PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The City of Fresno, PARCS Department, is proposing to replace existing ball field lighting fixtures on the softball field on the northeast corner of the park (See Exhibit B). The project also includes the addition of two ball filed light poles with fixtures, one will be located along the third base line and the other will be added to enter field of the softball field. The light poles will provide enough additional lighting to enable the field to be used for soccer and softball.

This project is exempt under Sections 15301/Class 1, 15302/Class 2, and 15303/Class 3 of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines.

Under Section 15301, the repair, maintenance, permitting or minor alterations of existing public structures that involves negligible or no expansion beyond current use are exempt from CEQA requirements. Section 15302 exempts projects that consist of the replacement of existing structures where the new structure will be located on the same site as the structure replaced and will have substantially the same purpose. Section 15303 exempts projects that consist of construction and location of new, small facilities or structures.

The proposed project consists of lighting upgrades for Melody Park and includes replacement of existing lighting fixtures and the addition of two new lighting fixtures for the park. The replacement and additions involve negligible expansion of the existing use. No adverse environmental impacts will occur as a result of the proposed project. None of the exceptions to Categorical Exemptions set forth in the CEQA Guidelines, Section 15300.2 apply to this project. Therefore, the proposed project is not expected to have a significant effect on the environment. Accordingly, a categorical exemption, as noted above, has been prepared for the project


