AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FRESNO. CALIFORNIA. UPDATING THE OFFICIAL ZONING MAP AS DESCRIBED BY SECTION 15-108 OF THE FRESNO MUNICIPAL CODE, AND **PURSUANT** TO PROCEDURES SET FORTH IN ARTICLE 58, CHAPTER 15 OF THE FRESNO MUNICIPAL CODE

WHEREAS, Rezone Application No. R-17-007 has been filed by Precision Engineering, on behalf of Butler Construction, with the City of Fresno to pre-rezone property as depicted in the attached Exhibit A; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Article 58, Chapter 15, of the Fresno Municipal Code, the Planning Commission of the City of Fresno held a public hearing on the 21st day of June 2017, to consider Rezone Application No. R-17-007 and related Environmental Assessment No. ANX-17-003/PM-2017-02/C-17-056/R-17-007 dated May 19, 2017, during which the Commission considered the environmental assessment and rezone application, and recommended to the Council of the City of Fresno approval. as evidenced in Planning Commission Resolution No. 13462, of the subject environmental assessment and rezone application to amend the City's Zoning Ordinance on real property described herein below from the Fresno County RA (Residential Agricultural) zone district to the RS-3 (Residential Single Family) zone district; and,

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Fresno, on the 27th day of July 2017, received the recommendation of the Planning Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Based upon the testimony and information presented at the hearing and upon review and consideration of the environmental documentation provided, the adoption of the proposed pre-rezoning is in the best interest of the City of Fresno. The Council finds in accordance with its own independent judgment that there is no substantial evidence in the record that Rezone Application No. R-17-007 may have additional significant effects on the environment that were not identified in the Fresno General Plan Master Environmental Impact Report SCH No. 2012111015 (MEIR) and that no new or additional mitigation measures or alternatives may be required. In addition, pursuant to Public Resources Code, Section 21157.6(b)(1), Council finds that no substantial changes have occurred with respect to the circumstances under which the MEIR was certified; and, that no new information, which was not known and could not have been known at the time that the MEIR was certified as complete, has become available. Accordingly, the Council adopts the Finding of Conformity prepared for Environmental Assessment No. ANX-17-003/PM-2017-02/C-17-056/R-17-007 dated May 19, 2017.

SECTION 2. The Council finds the recommended RS-3 (Residential Single Family) zone district is consistent with the Low Density Residential planned land use designation of the Fresno General Plan and Bullard Community Plan as specified in Figure LU-1 of the Fresno General Plan.

SECTION 3. The Council finds that the zone district of the real property described hereinbelow, located in the County of Fresno, is pre-zoned from the Fresno

County RA (Residential Agricultural) zone district to the RS-3 (Residential Single Family) zone district, as depicted in the attached Exhibit A.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall become effective and in full force and effect at 12:01 a.m. on the thirty-first day after its passage.
