RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDS FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION'S INFRASTRUCTURE FOR REBUILDING AMERICA PROGRAM AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF DOCUMENTS BY THE PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR OR DESIGNEE
