A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, TO VACATE A PORTION OF NORTH CARNEGIE AVENUE BETWEEN UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD AND WEST BULLARD AVENUE

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution of Intention No. 1118-D, on file in the Office of the City Clerk of the City of Fresno (City Clerk), a public hearing was held on December 7, 2017, at a regular meeting of the Council of the City of Fresno, California (City), at which evidence was heard for and against the vacation of the hereinafter described public street right-of-way, situated within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fresno is requesting the proposed vacation of a portion of North Carnegie Avenue between Union Pacific Railroad and West Bullard Avenue as shown on Exhibit "A," which is attached and incorporated in this Resolution; and

WHEREAS the purpose of the vacation is accommodate street improvements for the Veterans Boulevard/State Route 99 Interchange project, as well as the construction of the California High Speed Rail project; and

WHEREAS, the right-of-way was acquired by three separate documents, the first being a deed recorded September 14, 1990, by Instrument No. 90110656, Official Records Fresno County. The second was Tract Map No. 4358, recorded August 11, 1997, in Volume 61 of Plats at Pages 9 through 11, Fresno County Records. Finally, the third was by deed recorded January 14, 2008, by Instrument No. 2008-0004194, Official Records Fresno County; and

WHEREAS, the Traffic and Engineering Services Division, other City departments and utility agencies have reviewed the proposed vacation and determined

that the right-of-way proposed for vacation as shown in Exhibit "A" is unnecessary for present or prospective public street purposes subject to the reservation of a public utility easement over the entire area being vacated and also reserving a landscape easement over that portion as shown on said Exhibit "A".; and

WHEREAS, this action is being taken pursuant to the provisions of the Public Streets, Highways, and Service Easements Vacation Law (Cal. Sts. & Hy. Code §§ 8300-8363).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

- 1. The Council finds from all the evidence submitted that the vacation of a portion of North Carnegie Avenue between Union Pacific Railroad and West Bullard Avenue, as shown in Exhibit "A" is unnecessary for present and prospective public street purposes.
- 2. The public interest and convenience require, and it is hereby ordered, that as contemplated by Resolution of Intention No. 1118-D adopted by the Council on November 9, 2017, the public street right-of-way as shown in Exhibit "A," be and are hereby vacated and abandoned.
- 3. The City reserves a portion of the area being vacated for landscape easement purposes and the entire area being vacated as a permanent easement, to be used any time, to construct, maintain, operate, replace, remove and renew sanitary sewers, water mains, storm drains, and appurtenant structures in, upon, and over the public road easement proposed to be vacated and, pursuant to any existing franchises or renewals thereof, or otherwise, to construct, maintain, operate, replace, remove,

renew and enlarge lines of pipe, conduits, cables, wires, poles, and other convenient structures, equipment, and fixtures for the operation of gas pipelines, telegraphic and telephone lines, railroad lines, and for the transportation or distribution of electric energy, petroleum and its products, ammonia and water, and for incidental purposes, including access to protect such works from all hazards in, upon, and over the public street right-of-way to be vacated.

- 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this Resolution and shall file a certified copy, attested by the City Clerk under the seal of the City, in the Office of the City Clerk.
- 5. This vacation shall become effective on the date this resolution is recorded.
