PLANNED LAND USE	Existing- Community Commercial land use designation approved for this site by the Fresno City Council on December 18, 2014. Proposed- Neighborhood Shopping Center with a Type 21 alcohol license for proposed specialty grocery store.
ZONING	CC/UGM (<i>Community Commercial/Urban Growth Management</i>)
HOUSING ELEMENT SITE	The subject property is not designated as a Housing Element site.
PLAN DESIGNATION AND CONSISTENCY	The CC/UGM (<i>Community Commercial/Urban Growth Management</i>) zone district is consistent with the Community Commercial planned land use designation of the Fresno General Plan and West Area Community Plan.
ENVIRONMENTAL FINDING	A Section 15332/Class 32 Categorical Exemption dated October 19, 2017 has been completed.
