Secondary Research

- We are a relatively young city (Median age is 29.3)
- 10.3% of Youth ages 16-24 unemployed (California)
- 20% of Youth ages 16-19 are employed (Fresno)
- Out of 100 Metro areas in U.S. youth in Fresno place, 94th in being highly disconnected from employment and school
- Teen disconnection is 7.1%

Preliminary Data Analysis

- We collected 234 surveys
- We received surveys from each of the 7 districts
- Based on 16-21 yr olds surveyed, they have applied for an average of 2.5 jobs.

Preliminary Data Analysis

- Of all the eligible surveys of youth ages 14-21:
- Of those who have applied for a job, have applied for an average of 4.4 jobs.
- 3 in 10 (or 29%) have worked or are currently working at a job that pays in cash.
- Of all the eligible surveys, about 1 in 5 (or 22%) have participated in a job readiness program, or about 4 in 5 (or 78%) have not participated in a job readiness program.

Preliminary Data Analysis

- For Districts 1-3, youth applied for avg of 2.42 jobs
- 1/4 youth have applied for jobs

- Youth must be low-income
- Work-experience opportunities through All Youth One System
