PROJECT LOCATION: Sierra Sky-Park Subdivision
Generally located on the north side of West Herndon Avenue and south of the San Joaquin River bluff; and, between North Blythe and West Brawley Avenues in the City and County of Fresno, California.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Scope of work includes the replacement of existing water mains located within the Sierra Sky-Park subdivision, which have reached the end of service expectancy; abandonment of existing water mains and water service transfer; and, repair and replacement of paved surfaces with slurry seal as necessary within all affected street rights-of-way.

This project is exempt under Sections 15302 (Class 2/Replacement or Reconstruction), 15303 (Class 3/New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures) and 15304 (Class 4/Minor Alterations to Land) of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines.

EXPLANATION:

Section 15302 (Class 2/Replacement or Reconstruction) of the CEQA Guidelines exempts from the provisions of CEQA, projects consisting of replacement or reconstruction of existing structures and facilities where the new structure will be located on the same site as the structure replaced and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the structure replaced. Examples include but are not limited to replacement or reconstruction of existing utility systems and/or facilities involving negligible or no expansion of capacity.

Section 15303 (Class 3/New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures) of the CEQA Guidelines exempts from the provisions of CEQA, projects consisting of construction and location of limited numbers of new, small facilities or structures, installation of small new equipment and facilities in small structures; and the conversion of existing small structures from one use to another where only minor modifications are made in the exterior of a structure. Examples include but are not limited to water main, sewage, electrical, gas, and other utility extensions, including street improvements, of reasonable length to serve such construction.

Section 15304 (Class 4/Minor Alterations to Land) of the CEQA Guidelines exempts from the provisions

of CEQA, projects consisting of minor public or private alterations in the condition of land, water, and vegetation which do not involve removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees except for forestry or agricultural purposes. Examples include but are not limited to: Filling of earth into previously excavated land with material compatible with the natural features of the site; and, minor trenching and backfilling where the surface is restored.

None of the exceptions to Categorical Exemptions set forth in the CEQA Guidelines, Section 15300.2 apply to this project. Furthermore, the proposed project is not expected to have a significant effect on the environment. Accordingly, a categorical exemption, as noted above, has been prepared for the project
