**WHEREAS,** The City of Fresno recognizes that its entire diverse population should have equal rights and will speak against any oppression and discrimination which diminishes the quality of life for any City of Fresno resident or visitor, including those in its lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender community; and

WHEREAS, Pride originally began as a result of the riots at Stonewall Inn in 1969 when the lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender community desired better representation and a day to celebrate and recognize their own culture, a tradition that continues through this proclaimed day; and

**WHEREAS,** It is the duty of all of Fresno to advocate for those who experience hardship as a result of discrimination and inequality, because it is only through a community's unity that we overcome injustice towards all groups of people.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that the City of Fresno Mayor and City Council does hereby proclaim June 2, 2018 as:
