

- **WHEREAS,** Grizzly Fest was created by local music promoter and entrepreneur Aren Hekimian of the LAN Group in 2012, and has since grown into the premier music festival of Fresno, California; and
- WHEREAS, Grizzly Fest has become an annual celebration for music lovers from all over Central California who otherwise may not have the opportunity to experience live performances from such a star-studded group of artists; and
- WHEREAS, the artist lineup for Grizzly Fest 2018 is perhaps the most diverse and ambitious thus far, featuring Grammy-nominated artists Nas, Foster the People, Jhené Aiko, and Snoop Dogg, as well as homegrown talent Fashawn; and
- **WHEREAS,** for the first time in its history, the talent on display at Grizzly Fest will not be able to be contained within a single night as the event has expanded to two nights of entertainment at Woodward Park from May 18-19; and
- WHEREAS, Grizzly Fest 2018 is set to be the biggest and boldest event of its kind in Fresno.
