## **RECITALS**

WHEREAS, the City and the Consultant entered into an Agreement on June 7, 2016, (Agreement) to provide professional consulting services for the Fresno Sanitary Landfill Superfund Site, Phase 3 Groundwater Remedial Action (Project) for a total fee of \$464,700; and

WHEREAS, the City Council approved on February 8, 2018, a First Amendment to Agreement in the amount of \$56,700 and extend the Project to December 31, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Consultant have negotiated an \$84,400 increase in the Consultant's compensation for services related to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Consultant desire to extend the Agreement to March 31, 2019, to complete Project; and

WHEREAS, with entry into this Second Amendment, the Consultant agrees it has no claim, demand, or dispute against the City.

## **AGREEMENT**

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree that the Agreement be amended as follows:

- 1. The Consultant's sole compensation for satisfactory performance of the Project pursuant to this Second Amendment will be \$84,400. Compensation includes all expenses incurred by the Consultant in performance of such services. Total Consultant Project cost pursuant to this Amendment is \$605,800.
  - 2. The Agreement shall be extended to March 31, 2019.
- 3. Except as otherwise provided herein, the Agreement entered into by the City and the Consultant on June 7, 2016, and amended on February 8, 2019, remain in full force and effect.
