A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, CONSENTING TO AND AUTHORIZING INVESTMENT OF MONIES IN THE LOCAL AGENCY INVESTMENT FUND IN THE CUSTODY OF THE STATE TREASURER FOR PURPOSES OF INVESTMENT, AND AUTHORIZING CERTAIN FINANCE OFFICERS IN CONNECTIN THEREWITH

WHEREAS, the City of Fresno (the "City") is a chartered city duly organized and existing under and pursuant to the provisions of the Constitution of the State of California and the Charter of the City; and,

WHEREAS, Charter Section 804 establishes the position of Controller to be appointed by the Chief Administrative Officer with the approval of the Council, to have the authority and responsibility for the administration of the financial affairs of the City; and,

WHEREAS, by California Government Code Section 16429.1 ("State Law"), the State legislature created a fund, which the State Treasurer holds in trust, and which is known as the Local Agency Investment Fund (The "LAIF"); and,

WHEREAS, a local governmental official, with the consent of the governing body of that agency, having surplus funds in its treasury not required for immediate needs, may remit those funds to the State Treasurer for deposit in the LAIF for the purpose of investment; and,

WHEREAS, the Investment Policy of the City authorizes the Controller/Finance Director/(ex-officio) Treasurer to invest funds in the LAIF; and,

WHEREAS, designating and authorizing certain Finance Officers to execute transactions with the LAIF, including deposits and withdrawals, all in accordance with and as permitted under State law, for investment purposes; and,

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Controller/Finance Director/(ex- officio) Treasurer to delegate the authority granted by Charter Section 804 to perform the aforementioned financial and investment transactions and to provide for Council's approval a list of responsible Finance Department employees, along with their exemplar signatures, to be designated as Finance Officers, for the stated purposes;
