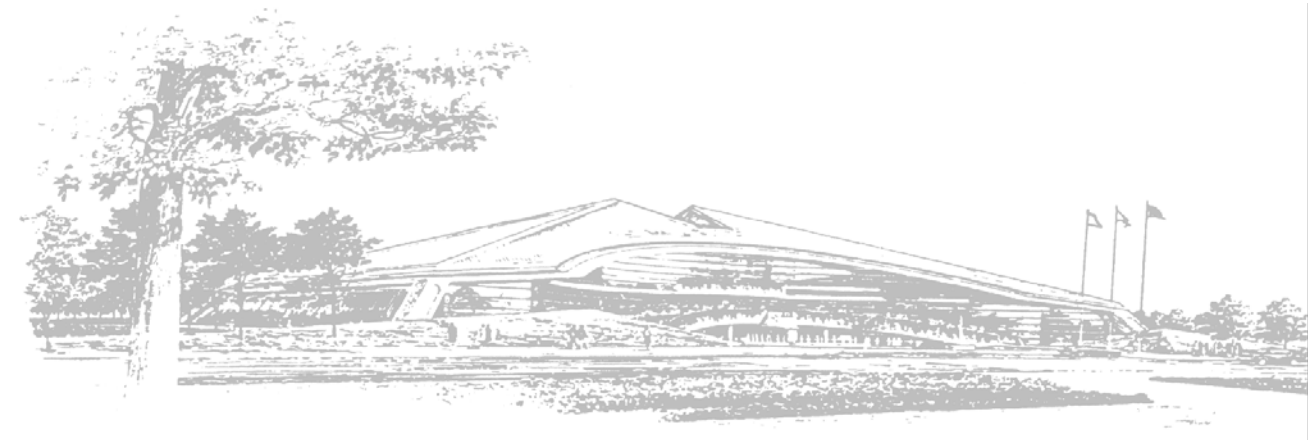


# City of Fresno
