SCORING METHODOLOGY

 - Home Repair
 - Homeless and Homeless Prevention
 - Public Facility Improvement
 - Public Service

- Applicant presentations will be 3 minutes each.
- At the conclusion of each presentation:
 - Staff will provide a 30-second summary of the internal review
 - Commissioners will have an opportunity for Q&A

FUNDING RECOMMENDATIONS

- Following all applicant presentations, HCDC will recommend funding allocations for each activity as follows:
 - Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG)
 - Housing Opportunities for Persons with Aids/HIV (HOWPA)
 - Home Repair (CDBG)
 - Homeless and Homeless Prevention (CDBG)
 - Public Facility Improvement (CDBG)
 - Public Service (CDBG)
