A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, DIRECTING CITY STAFF AND THE CITY ATTORNEY TO PREPARE AND NEGOTIATE A PROJECT LABOR AGREEMENT FOR AIRPORT FATFORWARD PROJECTS

WHEREAS, with its FATforward program the Airports Department is undertaking the largest capital projects in Airports' recent history, including a parking expansion and a terminal expansion;

WHEREAS, a Project Labor Agreement would provide uniform wages, benefits, overtime pay, hours, working conditions, and work rules for work on major construction projects, as well as providing reliable and uninterrupted qualified workers at predictable costs;

WHEREAS, a Project Labor Agreement would help to develop qualified workers in the construction trades and include people who are historically underrepresented in the trades; and

WHEREAS, the Council now desires to direct City Staff and the City Attorney to prepare and negotiate a Project Labor Agreement for the FATforward projects, requiring employing local, economically disadvantaged, pre-apprentice and entry-level hires, as well as veterans and women-owned businesses, to the extent permitted by legal and funding restrictions.

- 2. To the extent permitted by legal and funding restrictions, the Project Labor Agreement shall incorporate requirements for hiring local, economically disadvantaged, pre-apprentice and entry-level workers, as well as veterans and women-owned businesses.
- 3. This Resolution shall give City staff and administration the authority to negotiate a Project Labor Agreement, with the understanding that the final terms and language of the Agreement are subject to Council review and approval. The Project Labor Agreement shall be brought to Council for approval prior to bidding the FATforward projects.
