A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, ADVANCING THE "HELP US, HELP FRESNO" INITIATIVE.

WHEREAS, it is in the City's interest to educate its residents that charitable

donations have a greater impact when directed to programs that help the homeless; and

WHEREAS, it is difficult for a resident to vet the need and condition of a

panhandler, and to know whether their handout is contributing to more harm than good;

and

WHEREAS, local businesses and neighborhoods are often negatively impacted

by panhandlers; and

WHEREAS, the City partners with nonprofits to provide services to the homeless;

and

WHEREAS, a major barrier to the efforts of the City and local nonprofit service

providers are people in our City giving panhandlers handouts that dissuade them from

getting the help they need; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to educate its residents that handing money out a

car window undercuts the work being done by the City and local nonprofits; and

WHEREAS, the dual pronged goal of this Resolution is to educate the public to

contribute to the solution and support the services that help break the cycle of

homelessness, while also referring those who turn to panhandling towards those

services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

- 1. The City hereby enacts the "Help Us, Help Fresno" initiative to educate the public that directing donations to homeless service providers does greater good than giving a handout to individual panhandlers.
- 2. The City directs the placement of signage to disseminate the message of the "Help Us, Help Fresno" initiative. Signage shall be placed at intersections and/or areas selected in consultation with each Council District.
- 3. Signage shall be displayed in the form attached as Exhibit A to this Resolution.
- 4. City staff shall create a number to which residents may text a donation, and shall segregate all donations into a separate account. One hundred percent of the funds in that account shall be distributed to homeless service programs and providers as determined by the City Council. Council shall direct the expenditure through the annual budget process.
- 5. The City shall publicize the message of the "Help Us, Help Fresno" initiative through social media and other media outlets.
