A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, ACCEPTING THE SOUTHERN BLACKSTONE AVENUE SMART MOBILITY STRATEGY

WHEREAS, the City of Fresno applied for and received State funding for transportation planning through the California Department of Transportation's (CALTRANS) Sustainable Communities Grant Program for the purposes of completing the Southern Blackstone Avenue Smart Mobility Strategy (Strategy); and

WHEREAS, the City of Fresno entered into a Restricted Grant Agreement with CALTRANS on March 1, 2017, for the purposes of initiating and completing a Smart Mobility Study on Southern Blackstone Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the Strategy's study area is located on Blackstone Avenue extending from Dakota Avenue to Highway 180; and

WHEREAS, the Strategy provides the City of Fresno with community-driven recommendations to rebalance the public right-of-way within the study area to accommodate the need of pedestrians, bicyclists, and transit riders; and

WHEREAS, the Strategy provides the City of Fresno with recommendations to make the study area safer for all roadway users; and

WHEREAS, the Strategy provides a detailed estimate of probable costs for nearterm and long-term improvements as well as a funding matrix to implement the vision expressed in the document; and

WHEREAS, acceptance of the Strategy document does not formally commit the City to construction of improvements within the Strategy area but rather provides the
