A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA,  
ADOPTING THE FRESNO COUNTY MULTI-HAZARD  
MITIGATION PLAN UPDATE 2018

WHEREAS, the City of Fresno (City) recognizes the threat natural hazards pose to people and property within our community;

WHEREAS, undertaking hazard mitigation actions will reduce the potential harm to people and property from future hazard occurrences;

WHEREAS, the Federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 requires all cities, counties, and special districts to have adopted a local Hazard Mitigation Plan to receive funding from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA);

WHEREAS, under Assembly Bill 2140 (Hancock, 2006) (Government Code §§ 8685.9 and 65302.6), local jurisdictions are required to adopt the Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan as part of the safety elements of their general plans in order to be eligible to receive full reimbursement of the state share of post-disaster public assistance from FEMA;

WHEREAS, City fully participated in the FEMA prescribed mitigation planning process to prepare this Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the California Office of Emergency Services and Federal Emergency Management Agency, Region IX officials have reviewed the Fresno County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan and approved it contingent upon this official adoption of the participating governing body.

Be it resolved, the City will submit this adopted resolution to the California Office of Emergency Services and FEMA Region IX officials to enable the plan's final approval in accordance with the requirements of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 and to establish conformance with the requirements of Assembly Bill 2140; and

3. Be it further resolved, the resolution shall become effective and in full force upon final passage.
