A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA. ADOPTING THE FRESNO COUNTY MULTI-HAZARD **MITIGATION PLAN UPDATE 2018** 

WHEREAS, the City of Fresno (City) recognizes the threat natural hazards pose

to people and property within our community;

WHEREAS, undertaking hazard mitigation actions will reduce the potential harm

to people and property from future hazard occurrences;

WHEREAS, the Federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 requires all cities,

counties, and special districts to have adopted a local Hazard Mitigation Plan to receive

funding from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA);

WHEREAS, under Assembly Bill 2140 (Hancock, 2006) (Government Code §§

8685.9 and 65302.6), local jurisdictions are required to adopt the Multi-Hazard

Mitigation Plan as part of the safety elements of their general plans in order to be

eligible to receive full reimbursement of the state share of post-disaster public

assistance from FEMA;

WHEREAS, City fully participated in the FEMA prescribed mitigation planning

process to prepare this Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the California Office of Emergency Services and Federal Emergency

Management Agency, Region IX officials have reviewed the Fresno County Multi-

Hazard Mitigation Plan and approved it contingent upon this official adoption of the

participating governing body.
