BACKGROUND OF PROJECT (To be completed by Evaluating Department/Division. Explain need for project/equipment):

The Northeast Surface Water Treatment Facility (NESWTF) can currently produce up to 30-million gallons per day (30-MGD) of potable drinking water. During periods of high demand, the current 1.5-million gallon finished water reservoir restricts filter backwash operations, impairs operational recovery stemming from unanticipated shutdowns associated to water quality changes, and has limited storage available to support fire flow demands. The new 4.5-MG tank will resolve the current operational deficiencies and will be capable of supporting higher flow conditions when the NESWTF is expanded in the future.
