BACKGROUND OF PROJECT

The Police Department is in need of 25 standard gasoline powered Patrol replacement vehicles. Several vehicles have reached the end of their economic lifecycle. Replacement of these Patrol units is critical for the Police Department to effectively and efficiently provide public safety services within the city of Fresno. The vehicles will be delivered to the City of Fresno; after delivery, they will be upfitted with police radios and computers, emergency code three equipment, decals, prisoner transport seats and cages, as well as other varied safety equipment.

Note: One additional unit for the Police Chaplains group was bid with the 25 for the Fresno Police Department. The combined bid quantity of 26 allows for the best pricing on all units needed. The Chaplain unit will be funded from a donation to the Chaplains foundation.
