The above item was presented by Coordinator Ray Waller, and youth members Kionna Haygood and Vicente Ramirez from the organization Mobilizing Youth to Nix Tobacco (MYNT). MYNT is dedicated to reducing tobacco-related health issues that impact youth in the Central Valley. Coordinator Waller stated MYNT's goal is to pass a city-wide ordinance banning flavored tobacco products by 2024. He invited the commissioners to learn more at the Midwest Academy Strategy Chart meeting, to be held at Bitwise on January 28, 2019.

In response to commissioners' questions about support, Coordinator Waller responded that MYNT has an outreach strategy to work with City Council and requested the Youth Commission to support MYNT. Program Coordinator Espinoza invited MYNT to bring forth a proposal or policy in regards to banning tobacco products at a future commission meeting.
