BACKGROUND OF PROJECT (To be completed by Evaluating Department/Division. Explain need for project/equipment): The City of Fresno has identified a need for street restoration along East Ashlan Avenue between North First Street and North Millbrook Avenue. In December of 2015 the City applied for a Regional Surface Transportation Program (RSTP) grant to fund preliminary engineering and construction support services for this asphalt overlay project. The scope of work includes grinding existing asphalt, pavement overlay, reconstructing three curb ramps to meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliance, reconstructing one valley gutter, replacement of traffic signal loop detectors and pavement striping.
