A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING DISTRICT NO. 10

WHEREAS, on June 14, 2018, by Resolution No. 2018-135 the City Council approved the creation of Residential Permit Parking District No. 10 near the facility known as the Fresno Veterans' Hospital; and

WHEREAS, a modification to the enforcement hours and locations is necessary to minimize inconvenience to residents; and

WHEREAS, the Parking Division Manager of the City of Fresno, acting as the designee of the City Manager has determined the need to modify the boundaries of the residential permit parking district and adjust the enforcement hours of the residential permit parking district; and

WHEREAS, Article 20 of Chapter 14 of the Fresno Municipal Code (Code) provides for the amendment of residential permit parking districts pursuant to procedures set forth therein; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

- 1. Pursuant to Section 14-2007 of the Code, signs shall be erected on each block face of such District which prohibit stopping without a permit at any time between 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. Monday to Friday, excluding City observed holidays.
- 2. The revised boundaries of the District as shown on Exhibit "A" are as follows:

- a. East Terrace, East Harvard, East Brown, and East Princeton Avenues between Freeway 41 and North First Street.
- b. East Michigan Avenue between North Fresno Street and North Orchard Avenue.
- c. East Cornell Avenue between North Mariposa Street and North First Street.
- d. North Mariposa Street between East Princeton and East Harvard Avenues.
- e. North Angus Street between East Princeton and East Clinton Avenues.
- f. Residential properties on the north side of East Clinton Avenue between North Angus and North First Streets.
- 3. The terms of Resolution No. 2018-135 remain in effect and enforceable except the provisions of this Resolution.
- 4. This Resolution shall become effective and in full force thirty days upon final passage.
