I was born in Provo, Utah. I attended Brigham Young University High School and then Graduated from Brigham Young University, with a B. S. Degree in Business Management and Marketing.

I married, Stephen W. Lawrence, in 1968 in Salt Lake City where he managed a

B. F. Goodrich store. We are the parents of 2 children and have 8 grandchildren. In 1973 we moved to the Bay area and then came to Fresno in 1974 for Steve to manage the B.F. Goodrich store on North Blackstone Ave.

In 1976, we purchased the store from B.F. Goodrich Inc. and renamed it Blackstone Tire. We sold the store and retired in 2000.
