RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING GRANT APPLICATIONS FOR \$1,904,000 IN FORMULAIC FUNDS FROM THE LOCAL PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM FOR THE VETERANS BOULEVARD INTERCHANGE AND EXTENSION PROJECT PHASE 4B, AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF DOCUMENTS BY THE PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR OR DESIGNEE

WHEREAS, the Local Partnership Program (LPP) provides matching grant funds to eligible local agencies for the purpose of rewarding counties, cities, districts and regional transportation agencies in which voters have approved fees or taxes solely dedicated to transportation improvements or that have enacted fees solely dedicated to transportation; and

WHEREAS, the California Transportation Commission administers LPP and has requested applications from eligible agencies; and

WHEREAS, an applicant's governing body must certify by resolution, approval of the application; and

WHEREAS, if awarded the City of Fresno desires to apply for LPP funding and enter into an agreement with the California Transportation Commission, Caltrans and the Fresno County Transportation Authority to receive LPP funding;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

1. Approves the applications for grant funding from the Local Partnership Program for the projects and participation therein consistent with constitutional and local law requirements and this resolution.
