## Bautista Medical Group Scope of Work for COVID-19 Testing

The following represents the Scope of Work to be performed on behalf of the City of Fresno by the Bautista Medical Group (BMG), represented by Dr. Juan Bautista and Dr. Ignacio Guzman. The City wishes to engage the services of BMG for the purpose of providing rapid COVID-19 tests to vulnerable populations in areas of Fresno with larger populations of uninsured and underserved individuals.

Activities to be performed will include, but not limited to:

- Conduct 10,000 COVID-19 rapid tests of uninsured and underserved individuals at a cost of \$50 per test; a total of \$500,000
- Tests will be conducted at two fixed locations: Bautista Medical Group Sunnyside at 5539 E. Kings Canyon Road, Fresno; and Bautista Medical Group Downtown, 1350 O Street, Fresno; mobile testing may also be conducted with prior approval from the City of Fresno a
- Deliver test results to the individuals tested no later than 48 hours after they are tested
- Provide the necessary medical and other personnel to conduct 10,000 COVID-19 rapid tests; up to \$328,455
- Provide Personal Protective Equipment (germicidal wipes, isolation gowns, KN95 masks, sanitizer pump bottles, non-surgical masks, face shields, hand sanitizer, biohazard bags, gloves, shoe covers) necessary for the protection of the medical personal performing the tests and those being tested; up to \$128,245
- Provide basic medical care; up to \$58,300
- Conduct a marketing campaign in Spanish and English, including extensive social media, explaining why people need to get tested and offering free testing to those people who would otherwise not be able to afford testing; up to \$25,000
- Coordinate with the Fresno County Department of Public Health (FCDPH) to provide the necessary information of all people who test positive and request those people are contacted by contact tracers contracted with the City of Fresno and participating in the FCDPH contact tracing program
- Total contract/grant agreement not to exceed \$1,040,000
- All testing and marketing must be completed by December 1, 2020
- Provide timely progress updates to the City of Fresno and responses to information requests from the City's CARES Action Team representative
