Grant Proposal:

Every Neighborhood Partnership will support Councilmember Chavez in District 5 with Food Distribution in 5 focus areas in the months of August, September and October. These focus areas would be:

- Aynesworth Neighborhood
- Story Neighborhood
- Easterby Neighborhood
- Rowell Neighborhood
- Vang Pao Neighborhood

There would be at least 1 food distribution a month for each site. Each distribution would provide for a minimum of 400 food boxes.

Food would be purchased through the Central Valley Community Food Bank. Labor for each site would be provided by Every Neighborhood Partnership and their team of volunteers.

- Greenberg
