Re: Grant Proposal – Food Distribution

The Education and Leadership Foundation (ELF) is proposing to support Councilmember Mr. Luis Chavez in District 5 for the months of August, September, and October with Food Distribution in the following 5 focus neighborhood areas:

- Sequoia Elementary Neighborhood
- Jackson Elementary Neighborhood
- Winchell Elementary Neighborhood
- Eastwood Elementary Neighborhood
- Kings Canyon Middle School Neighborhood

There would be at least 1 food distribution a month for each site, and each distribution would provide a minimum of 400 food boxes.

Food would be purchased through the Central California Food Bank and other local food distributors. Labor for each site would be provided by the Education and Leadership Foundation in partnership with the office of Ayuda al Migrante at St. Anthony Maria Claret Church, as well as with Familias en Acción, a group of community leaders within District 5.

Matching Proposal:

The Education and Leadership Foundation will also serve District 5 with other ongoing food distributions in the following trailer parks and communities where farmworker immigrants reside. Some of those include:

- Campo Oaxaca
- Campo Church
- San Antonio Maria Claret Church community
