Estimated Budget: \$121,090.00

SEFCEDA is available to coordinate the distribution of food, including fruits and surplus food supplies. This process will entail a strong outreach effort to identify families impacted by COVID-19 that lack the basic resources of food. Many of those families have already been identified through other programs SEFCEDA is already involved in like workforce development, referrals of residents for job training and job placement programs and housing referrals.

One of the sites we are planning to use is the Grace United Methodist Church which was previously being used as a food distribution center and its location has been established and is well known.

A budget document is hereby provided to indicate the resources we believe are necessary for SEFCEDA to participate in the delivery of food in SE Fresno.

DELIVERABLES: Inform residents about food distribution dates to participants of our workforce orientations held monthly.

-Carry out food distribution events one time per month. It can be increased to two times per month if necessary.

DELIVERABLES: Monthly reports will be filed along with monthly invoices that comply with City of Fresno requirements.
