Virtual Inspection Program

What is a "Virtual Inspection"?

A "Virtual Inspection" is a remote inspection of conditions at a property, completed through the aid of technology and software.

How is it done?

- A contact call is initiated by an inspector using virtual meeting software
- The tenant, applicant, reporting party, accepts the call and begins video from their end of the call
- Inspector records the inspection, ends call
- Still photos are taken from the video and become the inspection photos that support the correction notice
- Case proceeds as normal

What software / hardware is used?

Benefits of a Virtual Inspection Program

- Minimizes public contact / Health and safety concerns
- Efficient use of time and resources increases productivity
- Improves safety for residents and inspectors
- Less "road time" for inspectors in the field, reducing pollution and risk of potential accidents
- Costs for deploying the software covered under CARES Act
