A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING THE "ANTI-
OPPRESSIVE GOVERNMENT ACT"

WHEREAS, on March 4, 2020, Governor Newsom declared a State of Emergency in the State of California related to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the March 4, 2020, declared State of Emergency, Governor Newsom has issued a number of emergency orders affecting the citizens of the City of Fresno; and

WHEREAS, Governor Newsom's actions have exceeded the statutory powers provided to him in the California Constitution and the statutes of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, the orders issued by Governor Newsom are arbitrary and capricious; and

WHEREAS, the orders issued by Governor Newsom are unconstitutional and infringe on the rights of citizens provided by the United States Constitution and Constitution of the State of California.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

1. The Council directs the City Attorney to initiate legal action against the State of California and Governor Gavin Newsom to repeal and terminate all state emergency order provisions related to COVID-19 to the extent they require closure or restrict the operations of businesses, schools, and houses of worship.

2. This Resolution shall be effective immediately.
