WHO WE ARE

- The Office of Independent Review (OIR) is responsible for ensuring complaints concerning the conduct of the Fresno Police Department (FPD), sworn and non-sworn, are thoroughly investigated to enhance community trust.
- The OIR monitors ongoing investigations conducted by the Fresno Police Department's Internal Affairs Unit (IA), and when completed, performs a comprehensive review of the process.
- Each review will focus on evaluating the adequacy, thoroughness, quality and accuracy of the investigative report.
- The OIR assists in strengthening the relationship between the community and the police department by promoting greater transparency and collaboration.

MAYOR'S CHANGES TO OIR

- New Duties for OIR
 - Full Time Position
 - Reside in the City of Fresno
 - Respond to Officer Involved Shootings (OIS), 24/7
 - Attend OIS Debriefings
 - Speak to Newly Sworn Officers
 - Ride-Alongs
 - Monthly meetings with FPOA
 - Established a Community Coordinator to engage with community or groups

COMPLAINT PROCESS

- Complaints regarding sworn or non-sworn personnel are received from the public, or initiated internally by the FPD.
- The FPD determines whether the complaint warrants a full IA investigation, or
- Assigned to a supervisor as an Informal Complaint (IC) and handled at the supervisor level, or
- Is simply a question about policy or procedure, classified as an inquiry (INQ), and is handled by FPD re-contacting the complainant and providing answer(s)

THE OIR REVIEWS

The OIR performs reviews of Fresno Police Department Internal Affairs investigations and the police departments' complaint process.

- Reviews are always performed in these cases:
- Officer Involved Shootings
- Use of Force Investigations
- In-Custody Deaths (ICD)
- Complaints involving alleged bias
- All other IA cases (Conduct, etc)

Reviews may also be performed in these cases:

- Any other major collision resulting from police pursuits
 Claims of retaliation for filing complaints against a police officer
- Other complaints as determined by the OIR

INDEPENDENT REVIEW PROCESS

- Await for IA to complete their investigation
- Varying time frames of a FPD IA investigation
- Items reviewed by IR (list is not totally inclusive):
 - Body worn camera videos, mandatory activation
 - Recorded interviews of complainant
 - Recorded interviews of officers/witnesses, length
 - Written FPD reports
 - Surveillance video from outside businesses
 - Automatic Vehicle Locator (AVL) data
 - Toxicology reports

REVIEW PROCESS (cont)

- Recordings of 9-1-1 calls
- Radio traffic
- Crime scene photographs
- Photographs of officers/suspects
- Officer training records
- IA History
- IA Final report
- OIR Review duration

REPORT FORMATS

Categories of Complaints in Report

- OIS/ICD, including OIS Dogs
- UNREASONABLE FORCE
- BIAS
- DISCOURTEOUS/CONDUCT
- ADMIN/PERFORMANCE MATTERS
- VEH ACCIDENTS

Report Changes to Enhance Transparency:

- Review all cases, including IC, charted in report with summary
- OIS Map
- Complaints Listed by Policing Districts
- Number of Citizen and Department Generated Complaints
- List suspended cases due to departure from FPD
- Discipline imposed by quarter and annually
- Respond to Community Questions/Requests
- Recommendations regardless of same finding/changes made to date

PROMOTING TRANSPARENCY

- Immediately requested meetings with all Councilmembers and offered to attend district events
- To date, met with five of the seven members
- Immediately began meeting with numerous organizations and groups
- Welcome in-office appointments (pre-COVID)
- Attend evening and weekend events
- To date, addressed or attended over 145 groups or events

TRANSPARENCY EFFORTS

- West Fresno Ministerial Alliance, 7 AM, 5 minutes
- SW Policing District Pastors- SPD OIS/Stephon Clark
- Community Chief Selection Meetings
 - Contacted those who expressed concerns afterwards/lack of personal knowledge or specifics
- LGBTQ Parking Lot in August
- Bringing Broken Neighborhoods Back to Life-OIS
- Following Death of George Floyd
 - Monitored many media formats
 - Contacted those publically expressing issues/concerns with FPD/OIR
 - Relieved of assignment
 - Guns and Drugs being planted/Police Corruption
 - Reform Subcommittee members
 - Release OIS report/family contacted OIR
 - Groups or Organization with members making public statements
 - National Lawyers Guild accepted
 - County Public Defenders Office accepted
 - Others did not acknowledge or respond to our offer

DELAYED REPORT FAQS

- Subcommittee/others contacted prior to statement
- Accepted invite with minimal advance notice
- Volunteered reason for delay, no attempt to conceal
- Second quarter report clearly listed case status and stated "TO BE RELEASED IN THIRD QUARTER REPORT" with the date the FPD completed their IA investigation, May 20, 2020. Also expanded on the allegations not previously made public.
- Resolution 2017-75, annual reporting, Aug/Sept 2021
- Resolution <u>2018-85</u>, OIR requested change
- Self initiated release within quarter of completion
- Previously OIR reviews were not always included in the quarterly report listing FPD findings/OIS and UOF
- OIS reviews were not always included in report
- Previously some case reviews were not conducted
