<u>BACKGROUND OF PROJECT</u> (To be completed by Evaluating Department/Division. Explain need for project/equipment):

In 2009, the State of California adopted a recycled water policy establishing a mandate to increase the use of recycled water in California by 200,000 acre-feet per year by 2020 and an additional 300,000 acre-feet per year by 2030. The Recycled Water Master Plan, prepared by the Department of Public Utilities, identifies opportunities to assist with compliance of this law by reducing groundwater pumping and replacing groundwater with recycled water for non-potable purposes (i.e. outdoor irrigation, dust control, fountains, etc.). On April 11, 2013, the City Council adopted the Recycled Water Master Plan and associated environmental documents.

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The scope of work for this Project includes construction of recycled water pipeline extensions from Recycled Water Distribution System Segment SW4 at the intersection of Inyo and A Streets. This Project includes construction of approximately 5,120 linear feet of 24-inch diameter and 656 linear feet of 12-inch diameter pipeline and will bring recycled water from the Facility's Tertiary Treatment facility located at West Jensen and South Cornelia Avenues to Gaston Middle School, right-of-way landscaping, a future satellite college campus, and residential and commercial landscaping within future West Creek Village/MLK Activity Center.
