NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Fresno City Planning Commission, in accordance with Sections 65090 and 65091 (Planning and Zoning Law) of the Government Code and in accordance with the procedures of Article 50, Chapter 15, of the Fresno Municipal Code, will conduct a public hearing to consider the items below. The applicant requests to establish a Type 20 alcohol license (Off-Sale Beer & Wine – sale of beer and wine for consumption off the premises where sold) for a proposed 7 Eleven convenience store located on the northwest corner of West Shaw and North West Avenues. On January 26, 2021, the Planning & Development Department Director denied the request based upon the project's compliance with the required location restrictions of Section 15-2706-F of the FMC and the inability to make the required findings for conditional use permits under FMC Section 15-5306. The subject application is being considered by the Planning Commission on an appeal by the applicant. At this hearing, the following will be considered:

- 1. Environmental Assessment No. P20-02834: dated April 7, 2021, a determination that the proposed project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) through a Class 32 (Infill Development Projects) Categorical Exemption; and
- Conditional Use Permit Application No. P20-02834: Staff recommends the Planning Commission deny the appeal and uphold the action of the Planning and Development Department Director to deny CUP No. P20-02834, a request to establish a Type 20 Off-Sale Beer & Wine alcohol sales license for a proposed 7 Eleven convenience store and service station.
