VII. CONTINUED MATTERS

A. ID17-1006

Consideration of Conditional Use Permit Application No. C-17-013, located on the southwest corner of North Figarden Drive and West Bullard Avenue. (Council District 2) - Development and Resource Management Department.

- 1. ADOPT the Negative Declaration prepared for Environmental Assessment No. C-17-013 dated June 12, 2017; and,
- 2. APPROVE Conditional Use Permit Application No. C-17-013 requesting to develop a commercial center consisting of a 3,764 square-foot ampm convenience store, an ARCO fuel facility consisting of eight multi-product fuel dispensers under an overhead canopy, a 4,000 square-foot retail building, and a 3,462 square-foot quick serve restaurant with a drive-through service window, subject to compliance with the Conditions of Approval dated July 19, 2017.
- 3. DENY Conditional Use Permit Application No. C-17-013 requesting to establish a Type 20 alcohol license (Package Store sale of beer and wine for consumption off the premises where sold) for the ampm convenience store.

The above item was introduced to Planning Commission by Development and Resource Management Planner III Kira Noguera.

Project Representative Bill Robinson spoke about the project.

Project Architect Julio Tinajero spoke about the project.

Cody McDevitt spoke in favor of the project.

Prab Gil, Bob Dil, and Dan Stein spoke in opposition to the project.

Project Representative Bill Robinson responded to their concerns.

Commissioner Vasquez inquired about Census Tracts. Noquera responded.

Chair Torossian inquired about alcohol licenses in the vicinity of the project.

Commissioner Garcia inquired about the other proposed buildings on the subject property.

Project Applicant Serena Mann responded.

Commissioner Vasquez spoke in favor of the project, subject to reduced alcohol sale hours.

Commissioner Bray agreed with Commissioner Vasquez.

Commissioner Garcia asked Representative Robinson if reducing the alcohol sales hours to midnight would be acceptable.

Representative Robinson confirmed the time would be acceptable.

Project Applicant Serena Mann indicated that conditions removing alcohol sales or preventing the 24-hour operation of the establishment would not meet their proforma requirements.

Project Applicant Brian Miranda spoke about the project.

Commissioner Garcia made a motion to approve the project with the condition that alcohol sales cease at midnight, and made the finding found in Section 15-2706-E-5-a of the Fresno Municipal Code.

A. ID17-1013

Consideration of Annexation Application No. ANX-17-001, Pre-zone Application No. R-17-002, and related Environmental Assessment No. ANX-17-001/R-17-002, filed by Bill Robinson of Sol Development, on behalf of Don Orosco of D.B.O. Development. These applications pertain to approximately 38.80 acres of property located on the northeast corner of North Polk and West Shields Avenues.

- 1. RECOMMEND APPROVAL (to the City Council) of the Finding of Conformity to the Fresno General Plan Master Environmental Impact Report as prepared for the annexation and rezone, dated May 5, 2017 for purposes of the proposed project.
- 2. RECOMMEND APPROVAL (to the City Council) of Pre-zone Application No. R-17-002 to pre-zone the property from the Fresno County RR (Rural Residential) zone district to the City of Fresno CC/UGM (Commercial Community/Urban Growth Management) and OS/UGM (Open Space/Urban Growth Management) zone districts.
- 3. RECOMMEND APPROVAL (to the City Council) of Annexation Application No. ANX-17-001 proposing detachment from the North Central Fire Protection District and the Kings River Conservation District and annexation to the City of Fresno.

Commissioners Garcia and Torossian inquired about the subject property and the neighboring properties that were originally proposed to be annexed. Lang responded.
