VIII. NEW MATTERS

 ID17-1294 Consideration of Conditional Use Permit Application No. C-17-091 and the related Environmental Assessment No. C-17-091, for property located on the north side of West San Jose Avenue, between North Nantucket and North Colonial Avenues (Council District 2 - Brandau).

> 1. ADOPT the Finding of Conformity to the Fresno General Plan Master Environmental Impact Report (MEIR), as prepared for the Environmental Assessment (EA) No. C-17-091 dated August 11, 2017.

> 2. APPROVE Conditional Use Permit Application No. C-17-091 which proposes the construction of a multi-family development of nine-duplex buildings and one-single unit building, contingent upon the related environmental assessment and subject to the Conditions of Approval dated September 20, 2017.

The above item was introduced to Planning Commission by Development and Resource Management Planner II Andreina Aguilar.

Commissioners Vang inquired about the recommendation from the Council District Implementation Committee, and the proposed setbacks. Secretary Clark responded regarding the implementation committee, and Aguilar responded regarding the setbacks.

Applicant George Russo described the project in further detail and provided elevations of the project.

Commissioner Bray inquired if the units were for sale or for rent. Russo responded.

Architect Jeff Cazaly spoke about the project.

- **B.** <u>ID17-1261</u> Consider Text Amendment Application No. TA-17-007, initiated by City Council Resolution on June 22, 2017. The purpose of this text amendment is to allow for an agreement to be established between the City and the owner of a security or electric fence that defends, hold harmless, and indemnifies the City related to the fencing.

2. RECOMMEND APPROVAL (to the City Council) of Text Amendment Application No. TA-17-007 amending Subsection F of Section 15-2009, and Subsection I of Section 15-2010 of the Fresno Municipal Code (FMC).
