# **SUBJECT**

RESOLUTION - Adopting Administrative Order 2-16 to be applicable to elected and appointed officials

## RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended Council approve the Resolution that would make Administrative Order 2-16 applicable to City elected and appointed officials.

#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The proposed Resolution would make AO 2-16 applicable to all City elected and appointed officials who are not otherwise covered by the AO. The AO addresses discrimination and harassment, and the procedures for reporting and investigating claims.

#### **BACKGROUND**

Proposed Assembly Bill (AB) 1661 mandates sexual harassment training for all public elected officials. Additionally, the Personnel Department is working on updating the AO to simplify it and address a number of recent changes in state regulatory law effective April 1, 2016. While preparing

these changes and in light of AB 1661, it became apparent the City lacks a policy and procedure for handling these types of matters, so the proposed Resolution would provide the appropriate policy and procedures.
