Authorize the Chief of Police to accept \$1,000,000 in grant funding for the SAKI grant awarded to the Fresno Police Department from the U.S. Department of Justice, through the Office of Justice Programs Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA)</li><li>2. Authorize the Chief of Police to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Rape Counseling Centers of Fresno (RCS) for a part time victim advocate throughout the three year grant performance period totaling \$53,618</li><li>3. ***RESOLUTION - Adopt the 16th amendment to the Annual Appropriation Resolution (AAR) No. 2018-157 appropriating \$281,500 for the Police Department's SAKI grant (requires five affirmative votes) (Subject to Mayor's veto).</li></ol>
